KEITH THOM HEINRICH JOINS SKELLY AND LOY'S CULTURAL RESOURCES STAFF



HARRISBURG, PA - May 24, 2018 - Skelly and Loy welcomes Architectural Historian Keith Thom Heinrich to its Cultural Resources Services Group. Mr. Heinrich conducts architectural history investigations under Section 106 of the National Historic Protection Act, including Phase I/II historic/architectural resource surveys, determinations of NRHP eligibility, effect evaluations, minimization and mitigation measures, and NRHP nominations. He also coordinates field methodologies and logistics for Phase I and II historic/architectural resource surveys.

Mr. Heinrich is currently working on an update of the National Register-listed Northumberland Historic District as part of mitigation for the demolition of a contributing building within the district. He is also preparing two Historic Resource Survey Forms for two properties in Berks County that are within the Area of Potential Effect for an intersection improvement project. In Mr. Heinrich's career, he has completed both archaeological and above-ground historic investigations. For the past 12 years, he has reviewed nominations for the National Register of Historic Places as a member of the Pennsylvania State Historic Preservation Office (PA SHPO). He also completed research on historic archaeological sites, including battlefield sites associated with the War of 1812 and the French and Indian War.

Mr. Heinrich holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Western History and Archaeology from Lycoming College, and a Master of Arts in Anthropology/Archaeology from East Carolina University. He is a member of the Register of Professional Archaeologists and Society for Historical Archaeology.
